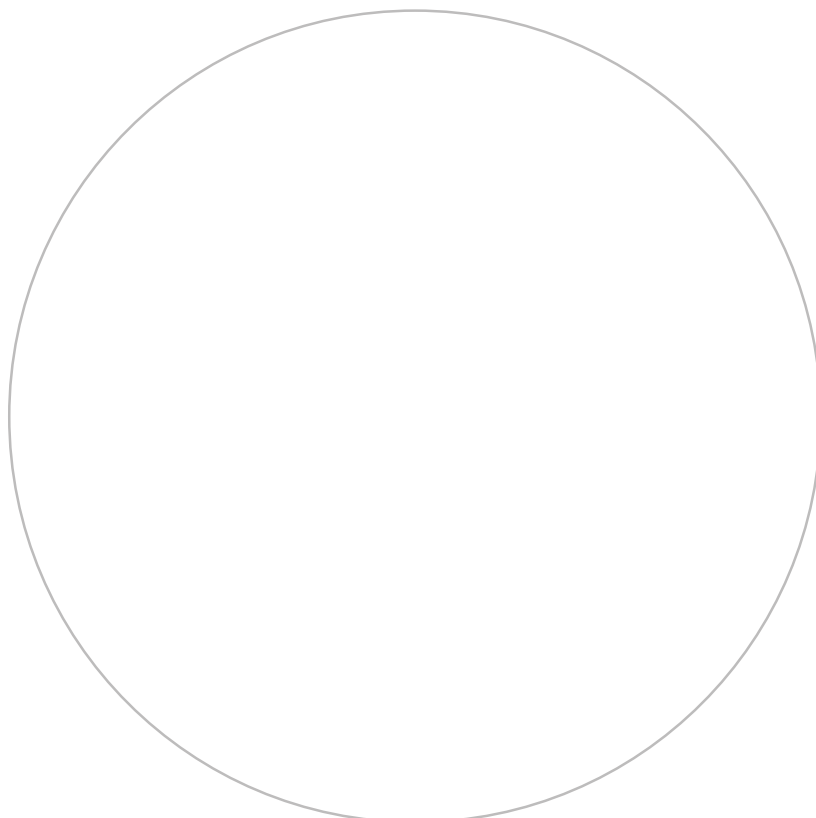
Think about what you learned and answer the following:
